Deliver a virtual mobility project

The Virtual Mobility Project Grants provide funding for members to deliver a [virtual mobility project](#) – such as an online summer school – in partnership with another university. One grant will fund a partnership between two medical schools, while a further five grants are open to applications from any department.
